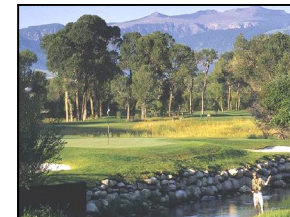
Anxiety and pain control in the year 2012;
