You will experience how the latest advances in material science have changed endodontics. Time, as well, will be dedicated to "Preventing the Separation of Rotary Files" and your learning practical and efficient techniques. Digital radiography and the use of ultrasonics will also be available to course participants. We will deliver "Just the Facts . . . Nothing but the Facts."

During this lecture/hands-on participants will learn:

1. How to create straight-line access that will expedite the endodontic process.
2. Discover how endodontics can be precision-based.
3. The importance of preserving coronal radicular dentin.
4. How to "machine" or "mill" an endodontic preparation.
5. The benefits of developing "endodontic synchronicity" between a machined preparation and a master cone.
6. The multiple advantages of performing a constant .04 taper preparation.
7. A new bioceramic one-cone obturation technique.
8. How best to restore an endodontically treated tooth.
9. The multiple benefits of piezo electric ultrasonics.
10. Most importantly of all, how to perform endodontics in such a manner that you do not compromise the long-term retention of the tooth. In fact, learn how to do endodontics so that you actually enhance the long-term retention of the tooth.

For the ultimate Real World Experience, attendees are encouraged to bring two to four accessed, extracted teeth.

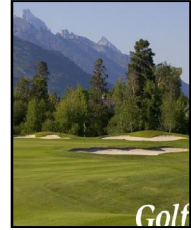

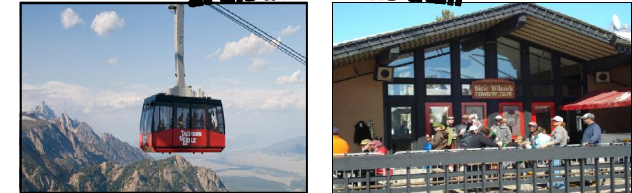
