Staging Complex Esthetic – Restorative Cases: Putting Things in the Proper Order
Dr. Thomas R McDonald and Dr. J Steven Smith

Modern dentists have developed vast knowledge in esthetics, occlusion, and restorative dentistry. However, when presented with a complex case many clinicians have difficulty deciding where to start and the proper sequence for treatment. Drs. Smith and McDonald come from two different backgrounds educationally but share a common approach to complex restorative cases, which is absolutely based on time-tested principles. The collaboration of these two “wet-gloved” clinicians provides a dramatic array of chairside, real-world, techniques. This course will outline a modern approach to staging that can be applied to today’s restorative practice with special emphasis on esthetics, occlusion, and segmental restoration. This approach is often more technically achievable for the clinician and particularly in today’s economic climate, more feasible for the patient.

1. The important components of a comprehensive exam
2. How to achieve a stable, repeatable starting point for the occlusion
3. How to refine the anterior teeth to achieve optimum esthetics and function
4. How to sequence a case in the proper order
5. The importance of segmental restoration for clinical predictability and patient acceptance



Dr. Tom McDonald is a graduate of the University of Georgia and the Medical College of Georgia School of Dentistry. He maintains a full time private practice in Athens, Georgia. Since 1983, Dr. McDonald has served on the faculty of the Medical College of Georgia School of Dentistry as Clinical Instructor of Oral Rehabilitation. He is a member of O.K.U., Distinguished Alumnus of the Medical College of Georgia in 1995, Fellow of the American College of Dentists, Fellow of the International College of Dentists, and Honorable Fellow of the Georgia Dental Association. A frequent lecturer in the area of occlusion, restorative dentistry, esthetics, and provisional restorations, Dr. McDonald has presented courses at many national meetings including the Hinman Dental Society, Chicago Dental Society, California Dental Association, American Academy of Operative Dentistry, and the American Dental Association.



Dr. Steven Smith is a graduate of Baylor University and Baylor College of Dentistry. He has maintained a full time private practice in Bozeman, Montana since 1983 and has been a visiting faculty member at the L.D. Pankey Institute since 1999. Dr. Smith’s areas of interest include bite splint therapy and its relationship to restorative dentistry, complex interdisciplinary dental reconstruction and exquisite conservative cast gold restorations.
