The new 2017 periodontal disease classification was recently released and is the first update on periodontal diseases since 1999. Of particular note is the new peri-implant disease classification. The new disease classification system is a completely different method of diagnosing the periodontal diseases. As is common with many medical conditions, the new periodontal disease classification now utilizes terminology of stages for the extent of periodontal destruction and grade for the consideration of risk for periodontitis. Utilizing the new terms of stage and grade, the clinician can better correlate periodontal treatment to the extent of periodontal loss.

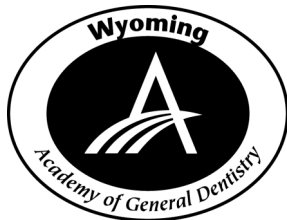
Goals for this course will be:
